TPF acts as the National Agency of Erasmus+ Programme, and coordinates several other international programmes including the popular Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship programme. Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship holders receive tuition-free education on bachelor, master or Phd levels and a monthly stipend to support their stay in Hungary.
